

Charter For The Trumpeter's Guild Of Kingdom Atenveldt

Be it hereby know by these presents that We, Mathghamhain, King, and Katerina, Queen, of the Kingdom of Atenveldt do charter for the greater glory and cultural wealth of the Kingdom by admitting the establishment of a Trumpeter's Guild.

Article I

The purpose of the Trumpeter's Guild is to provide for the heraldic and ceremonial utilization of Music for the proper pageantry of Kingdom events and for events of lesser divisions of the Kingdom. The specific musical instruments to be utilized include, but are not limited to: Herald's Trumpets (Clarions), Post Horns (Buzines), Cornets, Shawms, Sackbutts, Nakars, Side Drums, Military Fifes, Recorders, Bell Carillons, and Cymbals. These musical instruments are to be played at Kingdom, Principality, and Baronial events, upon request of the sponsoring entity, to augment the ceremonial functions of the Heralds in announcing the Lists, of assembling the populace, or for any use whatsoever as determined by the officiating officer in concurrence with pre-17th Century practice.

Article II

The officers of the Guild and its relationship to the Heralds of the Kingdom shall be specified in the By-Laws of the Guild, duly prescribed and approved by a majority of the Guild members voting.

Article III

Under the conditions specified herein, we grant unto the Trumpeter's Guild this Charter and charge it with the responsibility of enhancing the ceremonial arts and glory of the Kingdom of Atenveldt.
